Whatcha Need

Large white "flour sack" kitchen dish towel (approximately 22" x 38") 6' of satin ribbon, 1"–2" wide

White thread and needle (or an adult with a sewing machine) Fabric paints (tube paints for writing names or words)
Paintbrushes



- 1. Hold the dish towel up to your shoulders. Have a friend mark the spot where the towel touches your knees. (This will determine the length of the apron.)
- 2. Fold the dish towel over at the mark. This is now the top of the apron.
- 3. Lay the ribbon down on the apron as shown in illustration 3.
- 4. Fold the top corners down, leaving 5" open at the center.
- 5. Sew the folded corners down in a triangle shape (illustration 4).
- 6. Adjust the ribbon loop so it fits over your head.
- 7. Sew the ribbon down at each corner to secure it (illustration 5).
- 8. Use the paintbrush to cover the palm of your hand with paint and make a handprint on the apron. Continue until you have made the design you want. Add words and details to the design using the fabric paint and brushes.

Option: Paint your thumbs and then make thumbprints!
