

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

THE SECOND COMMANDMENT

ACTIVITY

OUR NAMES PROCLAIM

Theme: God's Spirit works in our hearts the desire to honor Him in the ways we use and regard His holy name.

Materials: Paper, pens or pencils, crayons, chalkboard or whiteboard, chalk or markers

Procedure: (5 minutes)

Direct students to print the letters of their name vertically. Then tell them to use the letters to write a special message (or descriptive words) about themselves. Encourage students to be creative. Chosen words may be silly or serious. Students may use more than one word per line. Here is an example:

Jesus

Always

Makes

Everything

Super

Ask students to give you names for God. List these on the board. Discuss the meaning these names convey. Stress that God wants us to honor Him by using His name only in prayer or praise or when talking with others about Him. Have students develop a special message about God using the letters of the names for God that are included on your list. Provide time for your students to decorate posters they make based on their own names; use crayon or markers. Then display the posters on a bulletin board with the title "Our Names Proclaim."
