RETURNING TO THE CREED

ACTIVITY

THE TRIUNE GOD IN THE SCRIPTURES

Say, **the Apostles' Creed tells us who God is and what He has done. God is the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—the Holy Trinity. The Creed summarizes the divine work associated with each person of the Trinity: the Father (creation), the Son (redemption), and the Holy Spirit (sanctification).**

The truths confessed by the Apostles' Creed come from the Bible. Let's find out where they are.

Divide the students into three groups, and give each group a sheet of paper or poster board and pens. Assign one person of the Trinity to each group. Using their Bibles, Bible apps, and catechisms, have students search the Scriptures to find references to their assigned person of the Trinity. Bonus points for finding references to all three persons in one verse or section.

Give students 5–10 minutes to work together. Then have each group share their findings with the rest of the class.
