ACTIVITY

SHOW ME GOOD STEWARDSHIP

Review the meaning of the word *stewardship*.

Stewardship: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care (*Merriam-Webster*).

Ask students to think about all that God has entrusted to their care. Make a list of all these things on the board. Examples: our bodies, possessions, talents, and so forth.

Divide the students into pairs. Each pair will select one thing that God has entrusted to them. One person in each pair will act out or say how to practice good stewardship with that item. Their partner will act out or say how to misuse, or not practice, good stewardship.

Example: my body

Good stewardship: eat right, exercise, get good sleep

Bad stewardship: eat junk food and soda, lay around, stay up late
