ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

I Love You Coupons

Give children index cards to make “I Love You” coupons to give to family members. Have them put their name and a heart sticker on each card. Discuss ways to show love in our families. Then have them draw a picture on each card to show love for a family member. Remind children that Jesus helps us show love for our family.



Action Rhyme

Sing this action rhyme to tune “Where Is Thumbkin?”: **Where is Daddy?** (*Hold up thumb.*) **Where is Daddy?** (*Hold up other thumb.*) **Here I am.** (*Wiggle thumb.*) **Here I am.** (*Wiggle other thumb.*) **God gave me a family. God gave me a family. Yes, He did. Yes, He did.** Stanza 2: **Where is Mommy?** (*Hold up index finger.*) Stanza 3: **Where is Brother?** (*Hold up middle finger.*) Stanza 4: **Where is Sister?** (*Hold up ring finger.*) Stanza 5: **Where is Baby?** (*Hold up pinkie.*) Say, **God gives us our families. Thank You, God!**



Family Play

Set out blocks and toy people. Encourage children to act out family scenarios. Talk about God’s gift of family. Also remind children that they are part of God’s family, too, through Baptism. Sing “He’s Got the Whole World in His Hands.”



Camel Watering Race

It would have taken Rebekah a long time to give water to ten camels. Put two buckets at one end of where you want students to race, and put a container of water at the other end. The students should race by using plastic cups to bring water, one trip at time, to fill their team’s bucket at the other end of the racetrack.
