

# Lesson 10

Forever Food  
Luke 22:7–23

## ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

### Lamb of God

Teach children the Agnus Dei, “Lamb of God, You take away the sin of the world,” from the Communion liturgy (*Lutheran Service Book*, p. 163). Tell them that the main part is sung three times. Explain that “mercy” means helping those in need. We need forgiveness, and that’s what Jesus gives us. Learning this song will help children feel like a part of the service during Communion.



### Remembrance Snack

Serve crackers and grapes cut in half. Talk about the elements in the Lord’s Supper. Remind children that Jesus loves them and forgives their sins.



### Passover Review

For children who are older, review the events of the Passover in **Exodus 12**. Read from the Bible or a Bible story book. Talk more specifically about the Passover meal (show pictures from online research) and how it relates to the Lord’s Supper meal.



### Make It Special

Show children a real chalice and paten, or pictures of them. Ask, **What are these used for? What are they made of?** Explain that they are often made from beautiful materials because we want to honor God with our best. Give children aluminum foil to wrap around cups and small plastic plates. This can remind them of how special the Lord’s Supper is. Remind children that most important is the blessing and forgiveness that Jesus gives in the Lord’s Supper.
