## A Resurrection Sign John 11:1–44

### ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

#### Jump-Rope Rhyme

Teach children this jump-rope rhyme to express their Christ-centered lives. If you don't have a jump rope, have children pretend they are jumping rope.



Jump and say:

**Jesus loves you and Jesus loves me.  
He is the one who sets me free.  
Free from death and free from sin.  
'Cause He died and rose again.**

#### Magnet Fun


Set out a variety of magnets with items that they attract (paper clips, magnetic letters, refrigerator magnets, nickels).



Say, **Magnets have the power to pick up some objects. In today's story, Jesus showed His power as God. Lazarus was dead, but Jesus made him come alive again!**

#### Bible Verse Fun

Show some seeds. **Could you make these dead-looking seeds grow into flowers? No, me neither. But God can.** Show a flower. **In our Bible story today, Lazarus was dead. But Jesus made Lazarus alive again. Jesus told Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25). Jesus died and rose again. One day, Jesus will raise us to eternal life with Him.**



Say the Bible Verse together: **"I am the resurrection and the life." John 11:25**

#### Butterfly Snack

Say, **Caterpillars turn into butterflies. They are a symbol of new life.**



Give children round crackers and pretzel sticks. Show them how to use the pretzel stick for a body and broken crackers for the wings.
