
The Kingdom of Children

## ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

### Traffic Light Snacks

Give each child a rectangular graham cracker. Frost the cracker with white frosting or cream cheese, and add green, yellow, and red M&M'S for traffic signal lights. **Who told the children to stop?** (The disciples did.) **Who told the children to come?** (Jesus did.)



### Showing Love

Talk about how Jesus loves all of us. He wants us to show love for others too. Sing this song to the tune of “If You’re Happy and You Know It.”

### Jesus Loves All People

Cut out large red hearts. Set out magazines, glue sticks, and scissors. Tell children to cut out people and glue them to the heart to show that Jesus loves everyone—of all colors and types. Have them draw themselves too. Say, **Jesus loves all people. Jesus loves you! How do you know?** (Jesus died on the cross for us and rose again; He gives us faith through His Word).
