### Preaching and Perils Acts 20:1-12; 2 Corinthians 11:22–28

## ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

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#### ☐ Advice for Eutychus

Eutychus was not misbehaving in church; it was just very late

and maybe a window wasn't the best place to sit. Ask children to talk about how they have been taught to behave in church. Acknowledge that sometimes it's difficult to sit still or stay awake. Have them take turns giving advice to Eutychus about what to do to stay awake in church.

#### □ Puppet

Puppet thinks of this song and asks to sing it (tune "Jesus Loves Me"): In Paul's work and on Paul's way, God was with him every day. In Paul's sorrows, joys, and fears, he was glad that God was near. Chorus: Yes, Jesus loves Paul. Yes, Jesus loves Paul. Yes, Jesus loves Paul. The Bible tells us so.

Puppet shares a time he was afraid but Jesus helped him. He asks children to share too.

#### Breaking Bread Snack

Serve juice and various types of bread, such as crackers, pitas, and tortillas. Tell children that

when Paul traveled to different places, there were many kinds of bread. Paul shared bread and God's Word with people.

#### Safe Landing

Prop up an open frame between two

pillows (or have two people hold it). Have children take turns throwing beanbags through the frame to land on one of the pillows. Remind children that we always have a safe landing in Jesus. You can make this a team or individual competition or do it for fun with no competition.
