ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

ID Tags

Give each child an index card with a hole punched in it to make an ID tag showing he or she belongs to Jesus. Have the child print his or her name and write “is God’s child” under it. Add a cross sticker. Thread yarn through the hole. Pull ends to make them even. Thread dry pasta or pieces of plastic straw over the yarn. Tie the ends.



Jesus Hugs Me

Sing to the tune of “Jesus Loves Me”:

In the day and when it’s dark, Jesus hugs me to His heart. And I know that He will be always very close to me.

Chorus: **Yes, Jesus hugs me. Yes, Jesus hugs me. Yes, Jesus hugs me. He never lets me go.**

Talk about how Jesus is with us and works through people to help us.



Military Appreciation

If your church has people serving in the military, talk about who they are and how they serve. Alternately, show pictures of people serving in the military (Army, Navy, Marines, National Guard, Air Force, Coast Guard). Help children gain appreciation for how the military keeps us safe from enemies. Say a prayer, thanking God for those who protect our country and us from bad people, and ask God to keep them safe. Make cards for them, telling them you are praying for them.



Healthy Snack

Serve trail mix or cut-up fruit and vegetables with dip. Talk about how God helps us to keep our bodies healthy by giving us good food to give us energy.
