ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

Move and Sing

Sing “Hello, Everybody” (*Little Ones Sing Praise*, p. 7). Talk about ways we are all different. Say, **We have different colors of hair or skin. We wear different colors of clothes. We like different kinds of food or animals. But one thing is the same. Jesus loves us all and wants everyone in the world to believe in Him so they can be forgiven and live with Him forever.**



Good News Song

Sing these lyrics to the tune of “Jesus Loves Me”:

**We can call on Jesus’ name,
For He loves us all the same.
He will take away our sin.
He will make us right within.
Yes, Jesus saves us. (Sing 3 times)
Good News for everyone!**



Peter’s Vision Diorama

Bring in a shoe box, construction paper, a white washcloth, play dough, and a male figure. Work together to build a diorama of Peter on the rooftop. Go online for examples. Make animals out of play dough. Use these and a male action figures or male doll to act out the narrative on your diorama.



Same and Different Snack

Give the children a variety of pretzels (small sticks, circles, twists, large rods). Talk about how the pretzels are the same in some ways and different in other ways. Say, **People look different from one another too, but God loves everyone. Jesus didn’t come to be just *our* Savior. He came to be the Savior of *all* people.**
