ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

Puppet Talk

Puppet says he wants to help missionaries tell about Jesus but doesn't know how. Let children give ideas.



Talk about how we can pray for missionaries, give offerings to help with their work, donate Bibles or Sunday School materials, send cards or letters to tell them we are praying for them, or send care packages to show God's love.

I Can Tell

Have the children copy your actions in this rhyme. Say,



Paul and Barnabas went here and there. (*Point right and left.*) **They told people everywhere.** (*Point in a circle.*) **They said, “Jesus died to take away your sins.”**

(*Make the sign of the cross.*) **All who believe in Him will live in heaven someday!** (*Clap.*)

Sing “I Can Tell” (*Little Ones Sing Praise*, p. 99).

Have children name someone they can tell.

Trinity Craft

The one true God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Give each child three craft sticks to color with marker or crayon, if desired. Use a permanent marker to write “Father,” “Son,” and “Holy Spirit”—one title on each stick. Glue end-to-end in a triangle shape or use glue dots. Add a loop of yarn for a hanger.



Missionary Support

Does your church support a missionary family? Show photos, use a map, and share information about the missionaries—where they serve and what they do.

Together, write a letter of encouragement and pray for the missionary family. Ask children to think of other ways they could support them.
