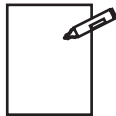
The Unknown Revealed

## ACTIVITIES

Choose from the following activities and crafts to help connect Bible learning to life.

### True God or True Idol?

It's easy to make things more important than God and put just about anything else ahead of Him. Make a list of false idols children remember from previous Bible accounts. Contrast them with the idols of today: sports, video, friends, money, and so on. Help children see that idols are not just something that happened in the Bible.



### Cross and Heart Snack

Serve finger Jell-O or sugar cookies shaped like crosses and hearts. Talk about how the shapes remind us that Jesus loves us and died on the cross for us.



### Cross Craft

Give each child a sheet of cardstock with a large cross outline on it. Place the paper on a rimmed baking sheet. Drop a marble coated in tempera paint onto the paper, and show the child how to roll the marble over the paper. Repeat, using several colors until the design is what the child wants. When dry, cut out the cross and punch a hole in the top. String with yarn for hanging.



### Revealed

Find a coloring sheet of Paul on Mars Hill online. Print enough for all children. Prior to the lesson, write “One True God” across each page with a white waxy crayon. As the students hear the Bible account and color with markers, the real God is revealed. The words will be in white surrounded by the colors and will stand out!
